

Good morning,

As a follow up to our conversation, should we be able to work out an easement agreement for the placement of the new well we would install our own generator.

The cost to run wire that far would be prohibitive and likely require an easement through the property which may also become problematic for any future developments.

Do this being at the early stages we would estimate that we would need approximately in the ballpark of 600 to 800 sq ft of clearance space to allow for entrance and equipment.
